



## Excavation at Oplontis May 24th to June 18th

A small team from SWAT Archaeology and members of KAFS will be working with the University of Texas on a research excavation at the world famous palace of Nero's wife Poppaea at Oplontis.

The palace was overwhelmed by Vesuvius in AD79 and buried.



The World Heritage site was partly excavated in the 1960's with stunning results.

This is a unique opportunity to join that small select band of archaeologists to have excavated at Oplontis/Pompeii.

Cost is £175 per week.

Accommodation and meals are not included.
